

**Ireland Home Based Services
Community Partner for Child Safety
June 1, 2022**

As of June 1, 2022, a total of 90 referrals had been received since March 1, 2022. A home-based caseworker (HBCW) was assigned to 90 cases, a home-based therapist (HBT) was assigned to 0 cases. There are 63 levels currently being serviced through Community Partners for Child Safety to assist 63 families.

Region 17 received a total of 33 referrals during the month of March. Of these referrals, 2 cases came from Crawford County, 14 from Daviess County, 4 from Dubois County, 1 from Martin County, 1 from Orange County, 6 from Perry County, and 5 from Spencer County.

Region 17 received a total of 30 referrals during the month of April. Of these referrals, 3 cases came from Crawford County, 9 from Daviess County, 7 from Dubois County, 0 from Martin County, 1 from Orange County, 9 from Perry County, and 1 from Spencer County.

Region 17 received a total of 27 referrals during the month of May. Of these referrals, 6 cases came from Crawford County, 8 from Daviess County, 3 from Dubois County, 3 from Martin County, 1 from Orange County, 3 from Perry County, and 3 from Spencer County.

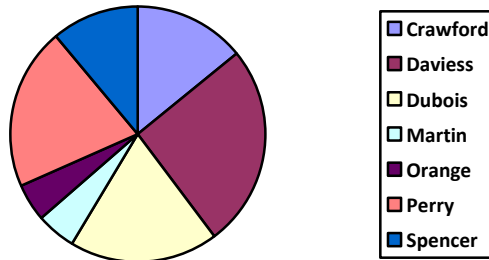

Recent Success Story:

This family self-referred for services. The family consisted of mother and two children. Mother had recently been released from Prison and residing in a halfway house. Mother referred for services for assistance in getting back on her own feet in order to have her children back in her care full time. IHBS helped the mother process what her experience in Prison was and mother voiced many times that she did not want to go back. Mother was willing to learn the importance of co-parenting and having positive communication with the children's father. The mother was introduced to community resources and modeled how to ask for assistance. Mother shared that she had high anxiety from being in Prison so long that she felt uncomfortable asking for help. After visiting two agencies for assistance the mother was able to speak for herself at the following agencies to advocate for assistance for herself. IHBS assisted the mother with completing applications for employment. Mother was able to secure full time employment and was also approved for Food Stamps. IHBS showed the mother how to budget her food stamps and her income. The mother has also made plans to save her income to allow for a car in the near future and housing once she completes the program. After services were closed the mother reached back out to provider to let her know that she completed the program, obtained housing and a vehicle and has shared parenting time with her children.
