



**Ireland Home Based Services
Community Partner for Child Safety
July 1, 2022**

As of July 1, 2022, a total of 276 referrals had been received since April 1, 2022. A home-based caseworker (HBCW) was assigned to 276 cases, a home-based therapist (HBT) was assigned to 0 cases.

There are 108 levels currently being serviced through Community Partners for Child Safety to assist 108 families. The priority list was eliminated on 6/30/16.

Region 16 received a total of 114 referrals during the month of April. Of these referrals, 5 cases came from Gibson County, 24 from Knox County, 5 from Pike County, 2 from Posey County, 68 from Vanderburgh County, and 10 from Warrick County.

Region 16 received a total of 85 referrals during the month of May. Of these referrals, 6 cases came from Gibson County, 14 from Knox County, 0 from Pike County, 4 from Posey County, 55 from Vanderburgh County, and 6 from Warrick County.

Region 16 received a total of 77 referrals during the month of June. Of these referrals, 1 cases came from Gibson County, 10 from Knox County, 4 from Pike County, 0 from Posey County, 54 from Vanderburgh County, and 8 from Warrick County.

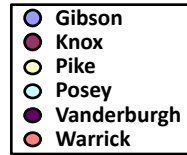
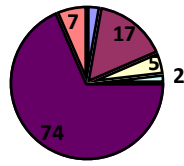

Success Stories:

This family self-referred for services in need of finding immediate housing. The family consisted of a single father and one child. The family had been residing in a hotel room and could no longer pay for the hotel due to the father losing his job. The father indicated that he had no family or friends that he could stay with and had no where to go. We sat with the father while he called Ozanam Family Shelter, the father was very abrasive on the phone and argued with staff. We discussed with the father the importance of communicating in a calm manner and modeled how to do that. The father was successful in obtaining shelter at Ozanam. IHBS connected the father with services at Aurora, helped him apply for Food Stamps and Medicaid and began the employment search. The discussion of appropriate communication was held weekly with the father and helped him identify calming mechanisms for him. The father was successful in obtaining employment and was able to maintain his work schedule. We assisted the father in applying for child care vouchers and obtaining child care. The father was able to secure housing of his own. With the help of concrete funds through Community Partners, Aurora and St. Vincent De Paul the father obtained furniture for his new home. The family was connected with a local church who intended to follow up with the family in the upcoming weeks.
